Palliative Care at Home is a partnership between a patient's primary care provider and other medical specialists such as providers, nurses and social workers. This service can be utilized even while continuing curative treatment. By providing high-quality care in the home, Palliative Care at Home helps improve quality of life for patients and families.

Palliative Care at Home offers the following services, as medically appropriate:

- High quality management of serious illness symptoms that can make living with a complex chronic condition challenging
- Education about the illness and options for care
- Counseling and support
- Care coordination between primary and specialty care providers and specialized care teams
- Health crisis prevention and management planning that reflects the patient's individual needs, values and goals for care

Co-pays: Palliative Care at Home visits are clinic visits in the patient's home. A patient's standard clinic visit co-pay would apply.
